

Steps for Making a Bird Nest

- 1) Take a 1-gallon milk jug & rinse thoroughly with warm water.
- 2) Dry out the inside of the jug.
- 3) Cut the bottom off of the jug & then turn the part of the jug with the handle upside down (looks like a large scoop). Discard the bottom piece.
- 4) Poke a few holes in the cap of the jug. This allows water to drain out of the container safely away from the baby bird.
- 5) Place dried grass clippings, shredded paper or other dried organic material into the container as a soft resting spot for the baby bird.
- 6) Nail the makeshift nest (nail through the handle of jug) into the closest tree where baby was found. Make sure that the nest is out of reach of neighborhood cats & children.
- 7) Place the baby bird into nest & the momma bird will do the rest. Once everyone has left, the momma will come & care for her baby.
